The more of ourselves we give to Jesus, the more his abundant grace will be poured into our lives.

We hope that a sermon series on 'spiritual disciplines' (ways which help us to grow our spirituality as disciples of Jesus) will help us grow as followers of Jesus and equip us to live faithfully in our weekday lives, not just on Sundays.
