General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

The GDPR is a European regulation intended to strengthen data protection for all individuals within the EU, and give control back to them over their personal data.

In order to comply with these new regulations we will need you to give consent for emails from St Sampson's including the monthly newssheet, prayer network emails and other emails about services and events. We will be asking you to fill out a form for your consent so we can hold your personal information and send

you communications by email and SMS (in the future!),

We will be giving out forms soon. If you don't fill out a form, we will no longer be able to send you those communications by email after 25 May 2018 (when the regulations come into effect). We are also taking the opportunity to set up a church database so that all the contact details we keep are kept securely.
